



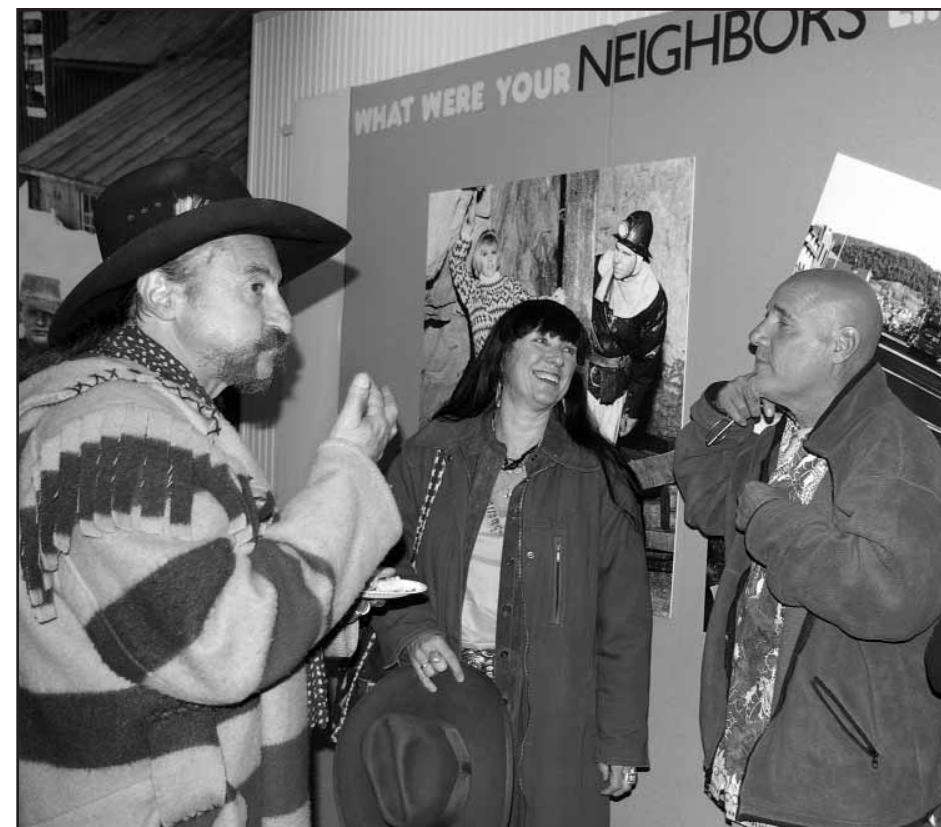
# Scary Masks & Costumes
